The City of Gulfport has scheduled an open-house public hearing in person to discuss the proposed construction of a new road extending the west end of Airport Road from Old Highway 49 to Daniel Boulevard with an I-10 overpass, making connections with Creosote Road/ Factory Shop Boulevard (at the Gulfport Premium Outlets), 34th Avenue, and Canal I-10 Service Road.

The hearing will be held on **Wednesday, July 13, 2022, from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. at the Gulfport Premium Outlets Food Court, 10000 Factory Shop Boulevard, in Gulfport, Mississippi.** All are invited to come and go during the hours of the hearing to view project exhibits and to speak to representatives concerning the project.
